**Rehoboth** means wide open spaces.

It is the name of the third well dug by Isaac in the valley of Gerar.

The first well was named Esek (quarrel) and the second Sitnah (enmity). When no one quarreled over the well named **Rehoboth**, Isaac said, "the Lord has given us room and we will flourish in the land."

The original Rehoboth Logo is curved around the picture of a woman drawing water from a well. The cross is a symbol of the foundation of our faith and the inadequacy in ourselves to bring about salvation, It is a reminder of our need to rely on God for wisdom in all things, including the education of our children.



The Latin phrase, Justum Et Tenacem Propositi, means Just and Steadfast of Purpose. In its original context, it is used to describe a man that will not be moved, either by the rage of 'misdirected' fellow citizens or a tyrannical government.
